Are you an OIF or OEF veteran?

The Wounded Warrior MENTOR Program provides one-on-one MENTORS to wounded/ injured warriors during their recovery and rehabilitation period while at WRAMC and after. Our mentors are military veterans, most with combat experience, who are retired and have had successful second careers in the private sector and government.

Do you know what you want to do next?

Our goal is to assist Wounded Warriors navigate the DoD & VA services and benefits while an outpatient **AND establish a plan for new productive life and profession,** focusing on the next 3 to 5 years after discharge or retirement.

College? Join the Workforce? COAD?

A MENTOR can help you with career ideas, internships, job interviews, college applications and select a program of study. A MENTOR can be a sounding board and offer you and your family support as you plan your next move after your wounds have healed. If you would like to remain in the military, a mentor can help you apply for the Continuation On Active Duty (COAD) process.

The WWMP is currently mentoring 250 Wounded Warriors and families at WRAMC. The WWMP also provides for a follow-on MENTOR when you return home.
